



This communication and the others sent about returning to school have been uploaded to [a webpage](#) together with updated questions and answers and images of classrooms and the dining room.

What the children will need on the first day:

The children can wear any BPS Uniform including PE kit (if your child has outgrown some items, you can substitute with home clothes). They should wear trainers as we will be active outside as much as possible. They do not need to wear a tie or blazer. Please bring sunhats to school daily.

To avoid contact between home and school, please can your child bring the following to school on the first day, which will stay in school.

- A dishwasher safe water bottle, clearly named on both the bottle and the lid
- Year 6 – a fully equipped pencil case and a pair of headphones for use with iPads
- Year 1 – a pencil case (Miss Law will send a list) a small bag containing a set of spare clothes and a pair of headphones (optional)
- Nursery & reception – a small bag containing a set of spare clothes (they do not have to be school uniform).

Staff will not be able to apply sunscreen to the children, so please make sure that they have sunscreen applied in the morning before school, and if you would like them to be able to reapply themselves during the day they can bring a named roll on sunscreen to school to keep in their tray.

Please don't arrive at school earlier than 8.00am and try to keep to the time slot for your year group. This is to help avoid contact between pods and to ensure that staff can park and get to the classroom to be ready for your child.
